The Mastering Shipbuilding Management week starts with an overview of the UK national shipbuilding strategy and an independent presentation on shipbuilding competitiveness/benchmarks.

Terms & Conditions

- The Full Event Fee is £3000.
- Paying the Full Event Fee secures a 'confirmed' place on the event and the full event fee needs to be paid by the 31st of May 2024 - late applicants will be considered after the 31 May, but on a case-by-case basis.
- The Deposit option is £1000. A deposit can be paid anytime to join the MSM waiting list (your waiting list position will be based on payment dates) for the event and the full event fee needs to be paid by the 31st of May 2024 to have your place confirmed.
- If the event is cancelled for whatever reasons, then a 100% refund of payments made will be provided, LJMU will not be liable for any travel or expenses commitments.
- If a delegate has paid a deposit and cancels, they will receive a 100% refund if they notify the Event Administrator by the 26th of April 2024.
- If a delegate has paid a full deposit and cancels, they will receive a £500 refund if they notify the Event Administrator between the 26th of April 2024 - 31st of May 2024.
- If a delegate has paid a deposit and cancels, they will receive £0 refund if they notify the Event Administrator after the 31st of May 2024.
- If the delegate has paid the full Event Fee and cancels by the 26th of April 2024, they will receive a 100% refund (e.g., £3000).
- If the delegate has paid the full Event Fee and cancels between the 26th of April 24 31st of May 2024, they will receive a £2000 refund.
- If the delegate has paid the full Event Fee and cancels after the 31st of May 2024, they will receive a £0 refund.
- Lunches will be provided each day.
- An Event Dinner is provided one evening as well as a single separate Social Event (no meal).
- The Event security level is Unclassified and is open to international delegates.
- Event fee does not include travel, accommodation, or any other living expenses.

The event organisers reserve the right to change the events contents, topics, location, and speakers at any time. Speakers may be changed subject to availability or due to their unexpected absence. Location changes will be limited to within LJMU city campus buildings where possible. Topic and content adjustments may occur in response to registrant feedback.
