- Subscription not ownership
- License limitations
- Concurrent users
- Geographical restrictions






- Where to find OA content

 - Open Access Button looks for an alternative source when you hit a paywall



Discover OA filter








Common misconceptions

- Ebooks can be accessed from anywhere

- Open Access content is not of a high academic quality
