CME: Viewing CMEs (Read only)

Guidance notes for internal staff to assist with accessing any online programme CME as read only.

This guidance may be helpful for Heads of Department/Directors of School/Professional Services Teams in order to monitor CME engagement and to review Programme CME data regardless of its approval status (i.e. completed or in draft).

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Access to Programme CMEs

From 2022/23 onwards, programme CMEs are set up by Academic Quality¹.

All staff with access to input/edit the reflection section or action plans have direct access to their CMES via the Programme Leaders Dashboard.

Anyone else, for example Directors of School or Heads of Department, can access programme CMEs as follows:

1) Reporting tab > CME:



Select either 'CME' for internal, or 'Collab CME' for collaborative.

2) From the main CME Homepage > Programme CMEs per Year



3) NB to filter by the correct Academic Year (in this case 2022/23) and then use the other filters to narrow your search e.g. by School or Programme Code.

CME Programme Report Groups & Action Plans




4) Access the CME data and any current narrative by selecting the 'View' link under 2022 Reflection & Action Plan.



Module CME

Access to Module Evaluations via the Programme CME and Collaborative Programme CME areas:

1) Select the **Self Evaluation tool** from the Modules sub menu on the right-hand side of the screens (Nb to look in both Internal and Collaborative Programme CME areas):



2) In the Module Search area, use the or the pre-selected checklists on the righthand side of the screen to find the modules you wish to review e.g. all incomplete evaluations.



Statistical Data

Data is aggregated to include all programme codes and intakes included in the CME group.

The list of students can be viewed via links in each section. The students listed in the popups are those included in the data tables.

Most of the statistics are measured across:

- OfS Subject Benchmark (Common Aggregation Hierarchy level 2)²
- OfS Degree Type
- OfS Mode of Study

Where programmes are split across multiple OfS groups, data summary tables will be available.

Click the expandable links within each section to view the data per individual cohort / year.

These links will display a breakdown of data at various different levels:


