Why is my screen blank when I log in?

Please use Google Chrome as the web browser to access the modules. If the screen is still blank, contact the IT Services Helpdesk via LJMU Help Me on your desktop.

Who do I contact if I have forgotten my Username and Password?

Why do I see an Enrolled message when I log in to complete the modules?

On the *Enrolled tab*, the message 'Currently you have not been enrolled in any courses. You will be sent a New Course Enrolment email when you have been assigned courses to complete.' The message means you have completed the modules previously, and to complete the modules again, you need to click on the *Completed Courses tab*. You can access the individual modules by clicking on the *Relaunch* button.

Which modules are mandatory, and how often do I have to complete them?

All mandatory modules have *Mandatory* in the module title. Details of the mandatory modules and completion requirements can be found on the Organisational Development web pages. https://www.ljmu.ac.uk/staff/organisational-development/elearning-modules

Do I have to complete the modules if I am on leave?

Staff on long-term sick leave, maternity, paternity, or adoption leave are not expected to complete the modules.

Staff on maternity or other parental leave can use a KIT day to complete the modules.

I am an Apple Mac User; how do I access the modules?

Google Chrome is the preferred web browser. It is available via either the *Start* menu if you are using University systems, accessing via *Citrix* or *VPN*.
